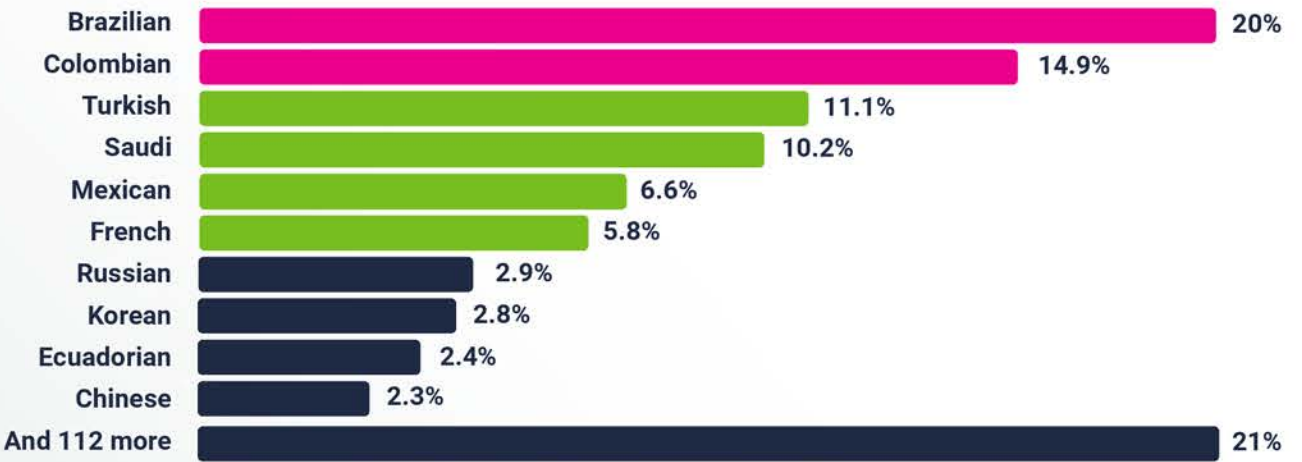
Nationality mix

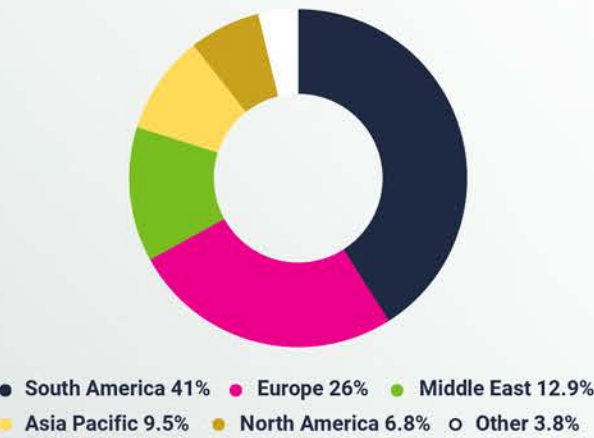

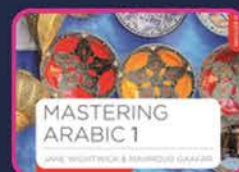

What are Skills?



BUILD YOUR OWN PATH.

WHAT ARE SKILLS?

Skills are an optional add-on to your General English course, and one of the smartest ways to get more from your time with EP. Whichever path you follow, you'll leave with more than better English. You'll leave ready for what comes next.

HERE IS HOW IT WORKS

At lower levels (A1 to B1), all students take Communication Workshop: practical vocabulary, speaking confidence, and the communication tools you need to navigate daily life, make yourself understood, and get the most out of your time abroad.

At intermediate to advanced levels (B1+ to C1), you choose the direction that fits your goals. Academic Skills covers speaking, listening, reading, writing and the academic techniques you need for university study. Career Skills covers professional communication, business English and the employability skills that employers actually look for. Both options are available at all EP campuses, year-round.

The result is a course that does more than improve your language. It prepares you for what comes next.

Language is the foundation. Skills are what you build on top of it. Skills are an optional extra which you can add to your general language course, running alongside your main lessons each week. These dedicated skills components are designed to make sure the language you are learning connects directly to what you want to do with it.

A1 – B1 Communication Workshop:

Practical speaking, vocabulary and confidence for daily life.

B1+ – C1 Academic Skills:

Everything you need to succeed at university or at qualifying English tests (such as IELTS).

B1+ – C1 Career Skills:

Employability and business English for using English at work.

IELTS preparation is timed to when students usually sit the exam. Where there is demand, campuses can add local skills, such as English for Hospitality in Malta or English for Real Estate in Dubai.

HOW YOU LEVEL UP

At EP, moving up a level is never a surprise. Every Friday you take a short test on that week's work, so you and your teacher always know what has settled and what needs more practice. Our levels run in ten-week cycles, from A1 to C1, and most students are ready to move up at the end of one. The decision is made by people who know you, and looks at three things together: your Friday results, your participation and attendance, and your teachers agreeing you are ready. If there is any doubt, a short progression test confirms you are ready or shows you exactly what to work on next.

The Communication Workshop course provides students with the language and skills they need to navigate everyday real-world situations in English. As well as communication, you will develop essential study strategies to be successful in your future English progress beyond your time with EP. From building relationships and developing transactional language to work and travel, you will get everything you need to communicate with confidence in a variety of everyday contexts.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

By the end of the course, you will have developed functional language to help you navigate a range of everyday contexts. You will have improved your intercultural knowledge and you will have built the foundations to keep building your English language and skills to achieve your future goals.

ACADEMIC SKILLS

The Academic Skills course is designed for students who want to perform and achieve their goals in academic contexts. Taught at intermediate level and above, it develops both your English skills and your academic and exam techniques across all four language skills: listening, reading, writing, and speaking. You will develop your 21st-century skills, such as collaboration and critical thinking, ensuring you are ready with the tools you need for your future studies.

By the end of the course, you will have mastered academic skills to use in your future studies. You will have developed the language and future-ready skills needed to be successful in an academic context.

CAREER SKILLS

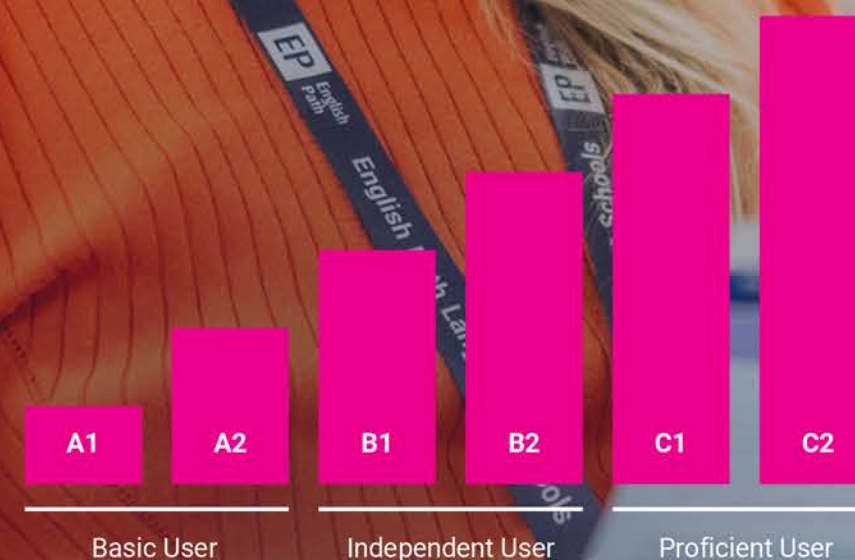
The Career Skills course develops both your English language ability and your professional communication skills. You will gain real-life experience using authentic workplace contexts, with a focus on the language and techniques needed for presentations, meetings, communication, negotiations, and workplace discussions. Teachers bring subject knowledge to every class, making this a practical and immediately applicable programme.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

By the end of the course, you will communicate more confidently and fluently in workplace contexts. You will have developed the skills, language and intercultural knowledge to successfully further your career.

Beginner classes operate on a rolling-enrolment basis, so you may join a class that has already started. It's normal to need 1–2 weeks to settle in and become familiar with the class and previously covered language. Our courses also follow a book cycle, with new coursebooks introduced at set points throughout the year. During the transition period between books, students may use photocopied materials until the new coursebook begins.

HOW YOUR COURSE GROWS WITH YOU

At A1 to B1, everyone who has booked the optional extra hour per week takes Communication Workshop, practical speaking, everyday vocabulary and the confidence to manage daily life.

At B1+ to C1, you choose your focus. Academic Skills prepares you for university, covering English for Academic Purposes, critical thinking and IELTS. Career Skills prepares you for work, covering business English, professional communication and employability.

Where each path leads: Academic Skills feeds into EP Pathways and on to a place at university. Career Skills feeds into professional certificates and our employability support, and on to work.

Also available alongside any course, where offered: specialised group courses, professional certificates and exam preparation.

Your timetable depends on the format you choose. Classic gives you 15 hours a week, either in the morning or the afternoon. Semi-intensive adds a daily skill class of one hour, bringing you to 20 hours. Super-intensive covers the full day at 30 hours, and is available at selected campuses. EP Malta also offers evening classes, from 17:30 to 20:45. Exact start and finish times can vary slightly by destination, so your campus will confirm your timetable before you arrive.

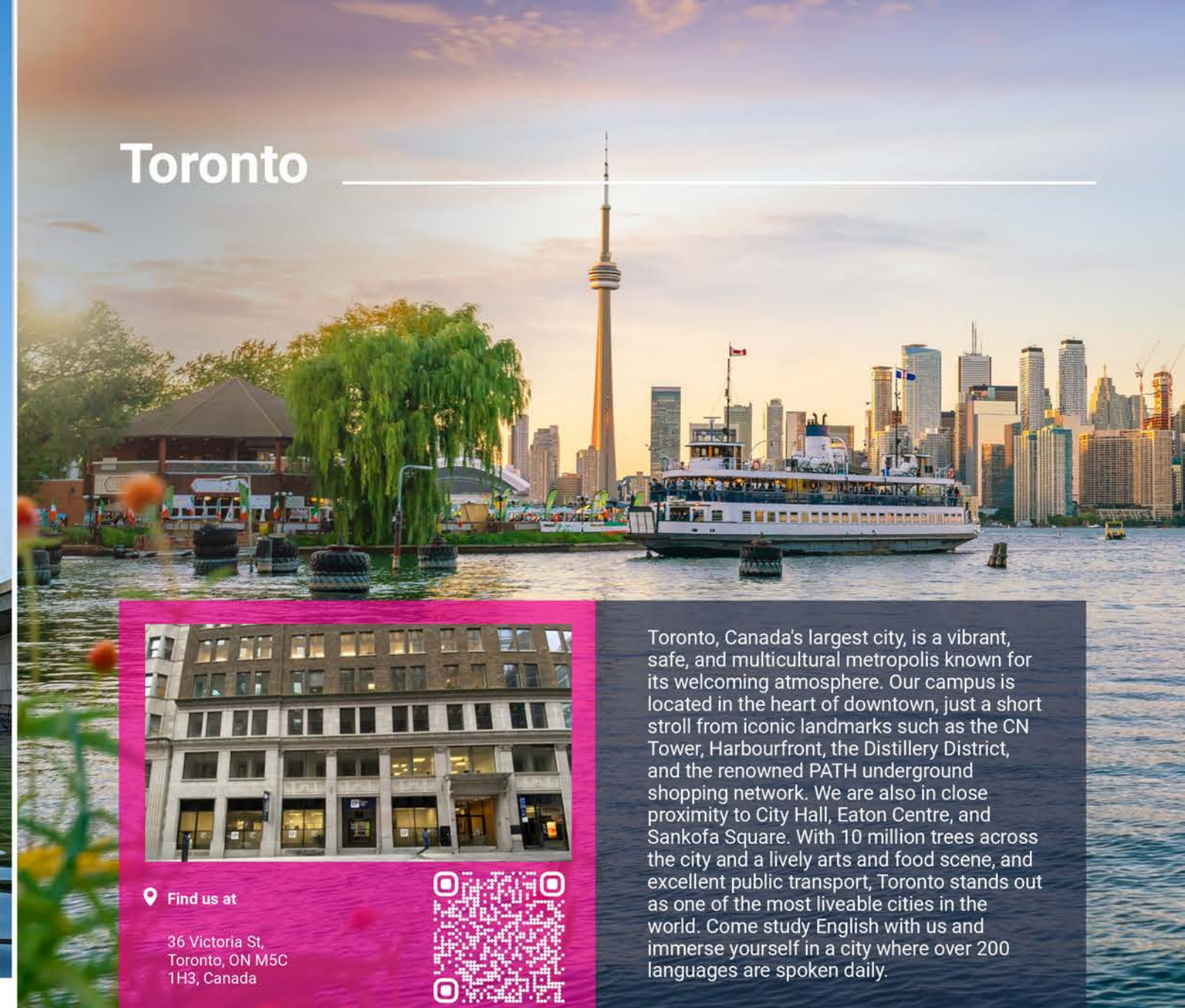
