Booking Student Accommodation in 3 simple steps

Step 1

You can indicate your preferred type of accommodation (homestay, shared apartment or residence) on the application form during your application for a course.

Our Student Services team will make a record the preferred choice of accommodation.

Step 2

EP will only be able to secure the accommodation option once the invoice has been paid.

Our team will send you the accommodation confirmation with further details regarding the selected option.

Step 3

You will need to confirm your arrival and send your flight details to our team, as soon as the flight is booked and no later than one week before the flight date. Our team will then be able to book and confirm your accommodation and/ or transfers and provide more details within the confirmation document.

If you arrive at a residence or homestay between 22.00 pm -08.00 am, you may be asked to book alternative accommodation in a hotel on the first night due to late/early arrival at the accommodation.

Travel time to school: 25-minute walk or 18 minutes by public transport.

Accommodation types:

Single room with en-suite and shared kitchen with your flatmates. Rooms are suitable for a single person only.

Reception/security desk: 24-hour reception.

Bedrooms: The bedroom contains the following: small double bed, pillow, bedding and bed-linen, chair, desk, bookshelf, window, wardrobe and drawers. It comes with en-suite bathroom and shower.

Things you need to bring: This

residence is offered on a self-catered basis. You will need to buy your own food, toiletries, and small household items, such as toilet paper and washing up liquid. You will also need to bring

your own towels.

Kitchen: The kitchen is equipped with an oven and hob, microwave, fridge/freezer, kettle, toaster, cutlery and crockery, utensils for cooking and preparing food and cupboard space as well as equipment for cleaning and ironing.

Facilities: Social spaces to relax, laundry facilities.

Extra cost facilities: Laundry facilities washing costs approximately £3.50/ dryer is approximately £2.00 - prices may vary depending on location. Student to provide their own washing powder.



Visitors/guests: Visitors, including overnight guests, are not allowed.

Noise: Residents are required to respect all other residents and maintain a level of noise that does not disturb others. Quiet hours are 10 pm-8am.

Smoking: No smoking allowed anywhere in the residence.

Cleaning service: Rooms are cleaned before check in, students are responsible for cleaning their own room and kitchen/living spaces.

Beddings/towels: Bedding and bedlinen is provided upon check in, students are responsible for cleaning of their own linen. Students are to bring their own towels.

Minimum weeks requests:

2-week minimum stay.

Check-in/check-out: Check in is from 4pm / Check out is at 10am.

Neighbourhood: There are some small supermarkets and restaurants near the residence. It is a 15-20 minute walk to Manchester city centre, 25 - 30 mins walk to English Path.

Accommodation location:

Manchester Piccadilly train station -10 minutes on foot/5-10 minutes by taxi. Manchester airport - 30-35 mins by taxi or public transport.

Important note: To lock their rooms, students need to touch the fob key on the sensor once they close their room door, otherwise anyone can open it.
