

Young Learner Student Code of Conduct

All Young Learner students must follow the general student code of conduct plus these additional rules:



SCHOOL

- Attend 100% of lessons and activities
- Lunch is provided
- Speak only English, both in and out of school

SAFETY (REQUIRED)

- Be home by 10:00 pm
- Never travel alone at night always go in pairs/groups
- Stay in well-lit areas
- Sit downstairs on buses
- Take care crossing the road. Watch for traffic UK drives on the left
- Keep your phone with you, make sure it's charged.
- Save English Path emergency number in your phone call if you get lost or need help

- NO strangers don't accept lifts or go anywhere with people you don't know
- Protect personal information don't share with strangers
- Be respectful to locals no queue jumping, say please/thank you, stay quiet when returning to host families at night
- Our Ratio is 1:20 for 13+ students and 1:15 f

FREE TIME RULES

After lessons/activities:

- Return to accommodation OR have limited time for local shops/sports with friends
- Return for dinner at time set by host family/residence (or ASAP after excursions)

Evening activities:

- Signed up with EP? → Must attend, tell host family/supervisor where you're going
- Want to go out after dinner? → Ask host family/supervisor permission first, tell them where and with whom











What you CAN do:

- Walk to local shops with friends
- Early evening cinema
- Sports activities with friends
- Respect curfew time (10:00 pm / 22:00)

○ What you CANNOT do:

- Leave the local area
- Visit pubs, bars, or nightclubs
- · Go anywhere with strangers
- Break the curfew time (10:00 pm / 22:00)

Weekends:

- At least one compulsory activity/excursion is included in course fee
- Free days follow same rules as above, and are expected to be taken place on Sundays, it is a bit more relaxed, but you will have mandatory activities to attend in campus
- Additional EP excursions available (ask Activities staff for prices)

HOST FAMILY

- · Give host parents your timetable
- Call if running late
- Quiet after 10:00 pm

RESIDENCE

- Sign in/out when requested
- No strangers allowed in
- · Leave building during fire alarms
- Quiet after 10:00 pm
- Follow all residence rules

ACTIVITIES & EXCURSIONS

- Attend all EP activities on time
- Listen to leaders and follow instructions
