How skills work at EP

- At lower levels (A1 to B1), all students take Communication Workshop: practical vocabulary, speaking confidence, and the communication tools you need to navigate daily life, make yourself understood, and get the most out of your time abroad.
- At intermediate to advanced levels (B1+ to C1), you choose the direction that fits your goals. Academic Skills covers speaking, listening, reading, writing and the academic techniques you need for university study. Career Skills covers professional communication, business English and the employability skills that employers actually look for. Both options are available at all EP campuses, year-round.
- The result is a course that does more than improve your language. It prepares you for what comes next.
