The EP Young Learners programme offers an immersive, inspiring environment where students grow in confidence and fluency, developing language skills and life skills that last a lifetime. Students can study English, French (in Paris) or German (in Berlin). We know these years are full of learning, curiosity and growth, so our courses are carefully planned to include fun activities, useful skills and creative projects.

Student safety

At EP Young Learners, your child's safety and wellbeing are at the heart of everything we do. Our safeguarding policies and procedures apply to all staff and partner organisations and are regularly reviewed to reflect relevant legislation, recognised safeguarding practice, and the requirements of the countries in which we operate. We are committed to providing a safe, supportive environment for every young learner and take any safeguarding concern seriously.

OUR SAFEGUARDING STRUCTURE

Safeguarding is built into every part of our programme. Our structure includes experienced global leadership, with senior team members trained in safeguarding and designated safeguarding responsibilities. Each location has trained staff with clear responsibility for safeguarding, supported by local and global management. Staff and relevant partners undergo appropriate background and suitability checks in accordance with local requirements and receive safeguarding training relevant to their roles and responsibilities.

MEDICAL CARE

If a student becomes unwell, our team will make sure they receive appropriate medical attention and support. Where medical care is required, a member of staff or the student's group leader will accompany them to an appropriate local medical facility, and parents or guardians will be kept informed. All students are required to provide completed medical and consent information before arrival so that we can respond appropriately to their individual needs. Where treatment results in an insurance claim, our team will assist with the relevant documentation and information where possible.

SUPERVISED TRANSFERS

For added safety, all student transfers must be arranged through EP Young Learners, unless a parent or legal guardian personally drops the student at the campus or school. This makes sure every arrival and departure is supervised and secure.

DAILY SAFEGUARDING ON CAMPUS

Code of Conduct: We keep clear expectations for respectful behaviour and professional boundaries.

Transparent Reporting: Any safeguarding concern can be raised at any time, through timely and confidential reporting processes.

Safe Activities: All excursions and activities are risk-assessed, supervised, and designed for age-appropriate engagement.

Parents and group leaders receive the 24/7 emergency phone number before arrival. Students are briefed on personal safety, local laws and cultural etiquette at the start of their programme. Our supervision ratios follow international best practice.

For residential programmes, our team lives in the same accommodation as students, ensuring 24/7 availability. Curfew times are strictly enforced, and all residences have controlled access and security monitoring.

VISIBLE AND IDENTIFIABLE

To help keep students safe and easily identifiable, all EP Young Learners wear an EP lanyard and ID containing key emergency contact information. Students are expected to keep these with them throughout the programme, including during activities and excursions, so they can be quickly identified and supported if needed.

WHY IT MATTERS

Exceptional experiences are only possible in an environment of complete trust. We hold ourselves to the highest safeguarding standards so that parents can have confidence, and students can give their full attention to learning, exploring and growing.

The academic programme

Our curriculum is designed to build genuine command of the language, not just classroom terms. Classes are small and interactive, taught by experienced teachers who specialise in young learners, and aligned with the CEFR framework from A1 (beginner) to C1 (advanced). Every student takes a placement test before arrival, so they study at the right level from the first lesson, and every student leaves with an end-of-course certificate.

Learning inside and outside the classroom

At English Path, we help every student reach their goals; in language, in skills, in confidence with people from other cultures, and in learning how to learn.

For our young learners, we do this through a clear lesson structure and a set of teaching practices we follow everywhere.



LESSON STRUCTURE

Students have three hours of class each day, split into two 90-minute lessons.

-  The first 90 minutes use an EP workbook built around the local city, so students learn the language and the culture together.
-  The second 90 minutes are innovation work. Students work as a team on a weekly project and present it, building language alongside skills such as collaboration, critical thinking, leadership and self-direction.

We write our own materials, and teachers adapt them to suit the students in front of them.



TEACHING AND LEARNING BEST PRACTICES

Our teaching and our materials work together, so that students:

- ▶ know what they are learning, and why
- ▶ know how to use it in real life, outside the classroom
- ▶ take ownership of their own learning
- ▶ produce work, receive feedback and improve
- ▶ build study skills they can keep using long after their course ends
- ▶ learn about the local culture and about each other's cultures.

The result is a classroom and an activity programme that support each other, rather than running side by side.



CLASS PLACEMENT

Every student takes an online placement test before arrival. We use the results, along with the student's age and nationality, to place them in the right class.



LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of the course, students will be better able to:

-  Think critically and check information. Tell facts from opinions, ask good questions, and look carefully at what they read online.
-  Communicate clearly in different situations. Share an opinion, weigh both sides, discuss difficult topics, and switch between formal and casual language.
-  Work together, solve problems and pitch ideas. Work well in a team, handle disagreement, create something with others, and present it with confidence.
-  Talk about life, culture and interests. Describe hobbies, food, travel, art and culture, and hold an everyday conversation.
-  Manage goals, time and independent study. Set personal goals, organise study time, use self-study techniques, and build strong relationships with people from different backgrounds.

Our programmes run across a range of vibrant international locations and dates, catering to a variety of ages and needs. Each centre offers a carefully planned schedule of cultural, social and recreational activities that support language use, intercultural understanding and personal growth. Every camp includes our core Explorer package. If you would like to do even more, you can add the optional Discoverer day.

Each week includes five half-day activities from Monday to Friday, plus one full-day excursion on Saturday and a programme of evening events. Sunday is a free or departure day, or an optional Discoverer add-on day. Depending on the time of year, weather, camp size, capacity, or other factors, lessons may run in the morning or afternoon, and activities may be grouped to allow for longer outings.

EXPLORER

(included in every full package)

Our core package. It offers a well-rounded mix of on- and off-campus activities: five half-day activities, seven evening activities and one full-day excursion each week, all supervised and designed to help students connect, communicate and discover their destination.

5 half-day activities, 7 evening activities and 1 full-day trip per week.

DISCOVERER

(optional add-on)

Everything in the Explorer package, plus one premium cultural or leisure experience, such as a special event or exclusive-access activity. This varies by destination and usually takes place on Sunday. Ideal for students who want a deeper, more memorable experience.

Everything in Explorer, plus 1 premium activity or excursion, usually on Sunday (varies by destination).

The Discoverer programme requires a minimum booking duration of 2 weeks.

Full experience

Everything in one place. Our Full experience programme combines 15 hours of CEFR-aligned tuition per week with a supervised residence, all meals and a full activity programme, so a student's whole stay sits inside one booking. Available to individuals and school groups aged 8 to 17, year-round at some centres and seasonal at others. Each week brings five half-day activities, seven evening activities and one full-day excursion.

Flights, local travel to and from the programme, and personal spending money are not included. Optional additional excursions and experiences can also be arranged at an additional cost.

The EP Family Programme: Learn together

The EP Family Programme turns a summer course into a shared adventure for the whole family. Students build their language skills through lessons and activities designed just for them, while parents or guardians decide how involved to be, joining the classroom, exploring the destination, or combining both. Every detail is built around flexibility, so each family gets the experience that suits them best.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

Accommodation is optional and can be added for the child, the accompanying parent or guardian, or both, depending on what suits each family. Visa & Entry Requirements for Under-18s:

- **Pre-Arranged Visas:** For nationalities that require a pre-arranged tourist visa, minors under 18 are processed under an accompanied family visa linked to an adult and cannot travel alone.
- **Visa-on-Arrival:** Minors (12-17) travelling without parents must meet airline Unaccompanied Minor (UM) requirements, carry a notarised parental NOC, and provide details of the adult receiving them in Dubai.

Visa-on-arrival is single-entry and lasts 30 to 180 days depending on nationality, so families must check it covers the full stay. Extensions of up to 30 days are possible when booked through EP Admissions.

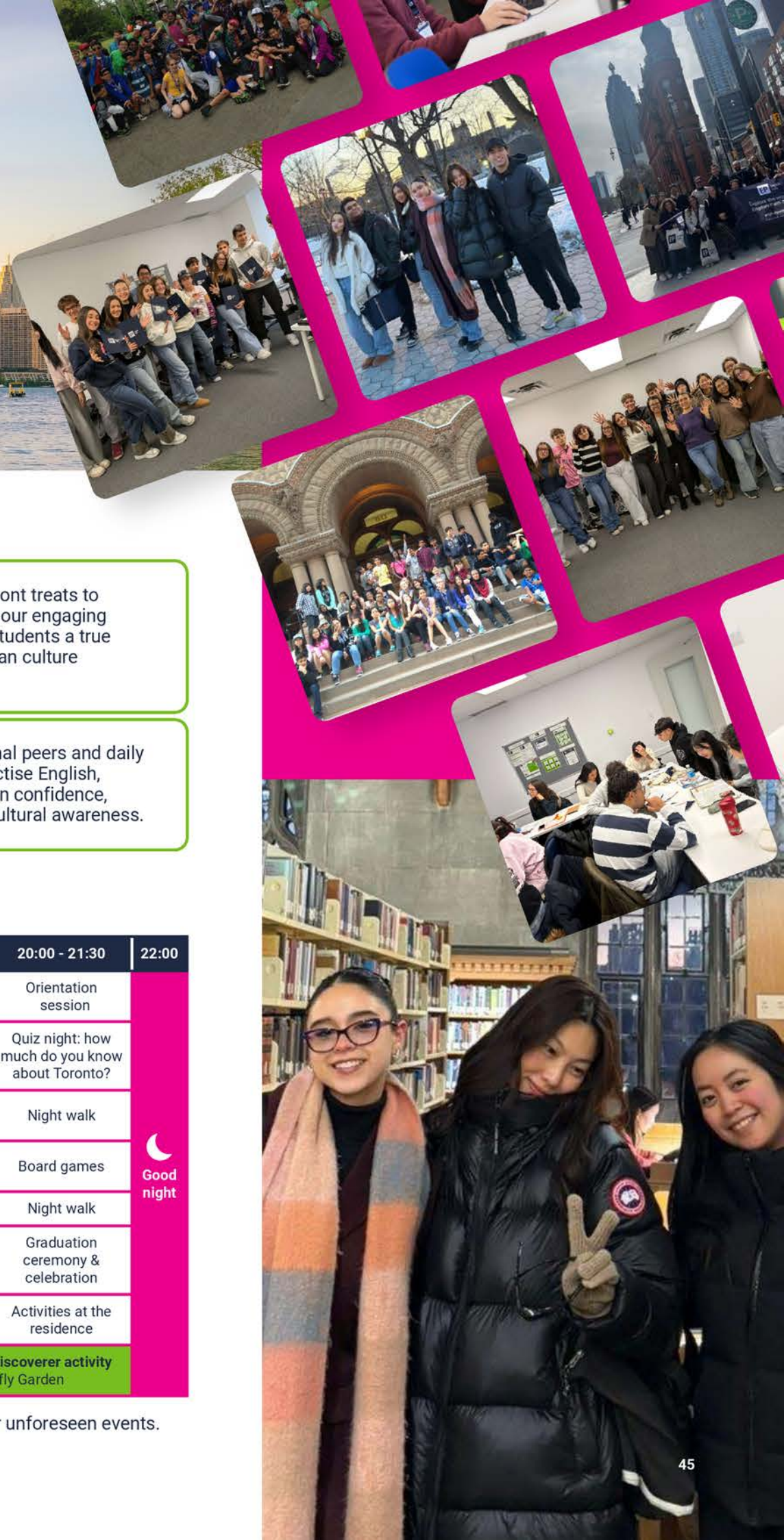
