- Lesson Schedule**

Final scheduling also depends on overall student numbers and other organisational requirements.

- Payments can be made online or via bank transfer.

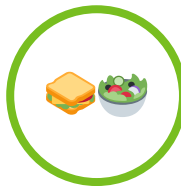

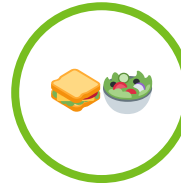
