ABOUT THIS COURSE

The Work and Study programme is the ideal choice for non-EU students who want to learn English abroad while gaining valuable work experience in Ireland. Through our General English course, you'll build the language skills and confidence to thrive both in the classroom and in your career, all while enjoying the flexibility to work alongside your studies in Dublin.

Our General English course develops your language and communication skills through a communicative approach. You'll practise listening, speaking, reading and writing, build your vocabulary, and learn to use more complex grammatical structures with confidence. Outside the classroom, you'll have plenty of chances to join social activities with your classmates, explore the city, and take part in our weekly social programme – open to all EP students.

HOW SKILLS WORK AT EP

- Every semi-intensive course is three hours of General English plus one hour of skills content each day. The skill depends on the student's level.
- Students at A1 to B1 study Everyday English Skills: vocabulary, speaking, and the practical language needed for daily life.
- Students at B1+ to C1 choose between Academic Skills and Career Skills.
- Academic Skills covers English for academic purposes (EAP) and IELTS preparation. Career Skills covers employability, business English, and other topics for using English at work.
- Both are offered at every school. Where student numbers are small, levels may be mixed within a skills class.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

By the end of the course, you will:

- Speak English more confidently and fluently
- Have developed your vocabulary knowledge
- Have a better understanding of more complex English grammatical structures
- Have fine-tuned your pronunciation
- Have improved your reading, listening and writing skills
