Morning lessons run from 09:00 – 13:00. If the programme offers afternoon lessons, these run approximately from 13:30 – 17:30.

- Lesson Schedule

Lessons may be scheduled in the morning or afternoon at the school's discretion. This will depend on various operational factors, including weather conditions at the destination (e.g., during periods of high heat, students may remain at the school for lessons to ensure their wellbeing). Final scheduling also depends on overall student numbers and other organisational requirements.

- Transfers:

Unaccompanied Minors (UM) Service: Assisted airport check-in for unaccompanied minors can be arranged on request. Service costs €95.

Please note: individual transfer must be booked with English Path (unless parents/guardians are dropping off students at the accommodation/centre).

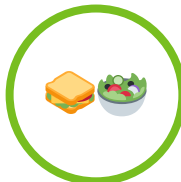

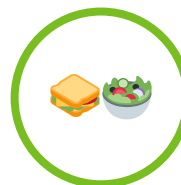

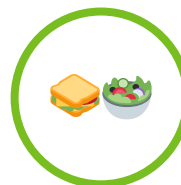
