Introduction

The EAP + IELTS 6.5 programme prepares you to perform a wide range of general and academic tasks at an advanced English level equivalent to IELTS 5.5 –6.5. While the primary aim of the course is to strengthen your English for Academic Purposes and equip you with the skills needed for success in Higher Education, it also builds your confidence and provides effective strategies for the IELTS test.

The programme includes EAP-specific assessments and tasks aligned with IELTS-style criteria, helping you understand expectations while developing overall language proficiency. Throughout the course, you will improve your academic speaking, listening, reading and writing skills, gaining the language competence needed for further academic study.

Entry to the programme requires IELTS 5.5 or equivalent, and successful participants are able to progress to their chosen academic pathways. Daily lessons combine targeted language development with essential academic training delivered by experienced tutors. You will develop key academic skills such as note-taking, referencing, critical reading and presenting, while independent study enables you to apply what you learn in class.



Course content

As an English for Academic Purposes programme, the course's main focus is on developing the academic English, study skills, and communication strategies you need for successful progression into Higher Education. This structured programme develops academic skills and English through regular assessment, one-on-one tutor feedback, and integrated IELTS-style tasks to prepare you for the exam required for university entry.

Preparation for the IELTS test will include you reviewing essential academic vocabulary and expressions, practising effective strategies for each IELTS test section, and completing focused tasks in reading, listening, writing, and speaking. You will refine your writing accuracy and organisation, develop clearer ideas, strengthen listening and reading speed and comprehension, and improve grammar through targeted practice.

The course also includes practice with real IELTS test papers, a full timed mock exam, and personalised feedback to address remaining weaknesses, helping you build the competence and confidence needed for success in both academic study and the IELTS test.

Progression

Upon successfully completing the course, you will receive:

- An official IELTS test result, which is recognised globally for university admission*
- An EP certificate confirming the academic English level you reached and assessment record detailing final grades.
