Course description

The Arabic Language Programme develops your communication skills and confidence to function in everyday situations across Dubai, Riyadh and beyond. Through a structured, communicative approach, you will develop listening, speaking, reading and writing while building essential vocabulary and core grammar.

The course is built on Modern Standard Arabic (MSA) and integrates local dialects from the UAE and KSA to support real-life interactions, helping you communicate effectively in daily, social and workplace settings

What is included

- 24 one-hour lessons per sub-level
- Small group classes (6–8 students)
- CEFR-aligned structured syllabus
- Modern Standard Arabic with UAE/KSA dialect integration
- Placement assessment before starting
- End-of-sub-level progress certificate

- Have improved your pronunciation, including sounds unique to Arabic
- Have strengthened your reading, listening and writing skills in Arabic
- Be able to understand and use both Modern Standard Arabic and relevant local dialect (UAE/KSA) in practical situations

3. Pay fees the week prior to starting your course
4. Begin your programme
