Student safety

At EP Young Learners, your child's safety is our top priority. We are fully committed to creating a secure and supportive environment where every student feels protected, respected, and cared for. Our safeguarding policies follow the British Council's global standards and reflect a zero-tolerance approach to any form of neglect or abuse. These policies apply to all staff, partners, and service providers, from airport transfers to activity leaders, and are regularly reviewed to ensure they meet the highest legal and ethical standards.

Our safeguarding structure

At EP Young Learners, safeguarding is built into every part of our programme. Our structure includes experienced head office leadership, with many of our senior team members trained as Designated Safeguarding Leads. Each location also has a dedicated, trained staff member responsible for all safeguarding operations, from enforcing policies to ensuring student well-being, with ongoing support from local and global management.

All our staff and trusted partners undergo enhanced background checks and receive regular safeguarding training. This ensures that everyone working with us is fully aware of their responsibilities and equipped to create a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all learners.

If a student becomes unwell during the programme, our staff will ensure they receive prompt medical attention. A staff member or the group leader will accompany them to a trusted medical centre or hospital, and parents will be informed immediately. All students must have a completed medical consent form on file before arrival to ensure we can act quickly in case of emergencies. We will assist with any documentation required for claim.

For added safety, all student transfers must be arranged through EP Young Learners unless a parent or legal guardian personally drops the student off at campus or school. This ensures every arrival and departure is supervised and secure.

Daily safeguarding on campus

- ✓ **Code of Conduct:** We maintain clear expectations for respectful behaviour and professional boundaries
- ✓ **Transparent Reporting:** Any safeguarding concern can be raised at any time; timely, confidential reporting processes are in place.
- ✓ **Safe Activities:** All excursions and activities are risk-assessed, supervised, and designed for age-appropriate engagement.
- ✓ **Parents and group leaders** will receive the 24/7 emergency phone number prior to arrival. Students are also briefed on personal safety, local laws, and cultural etiquette at the start of their programme.
- ✓ **Our supervision ratios** follow international best practices, having one staff member for every 15 students during excursions and activities. For residential programmes, our team lives in the same accommodation as students, ensuring 24/7 availability. Curfew times are strictly enforced, and all residences have controlled access and security monitoring.



To help keep our students safe and visible at all times, all EP Young Learners wear branded wristbands and IDs with key emergency contacts. This simple measure ensures they can be quickly identified and supported, especially during excursions.
